BAPTISM BASICS ~ ANSWERS

I. Why should we be baptized?

- 1. To OBEY Jesus (Matthew 28:18-20). To become a disciple of Jesus.
- 2. To follow the <u>EXAMPLE</u> of Jesus (Matthew 3:13-17). "Now" & "To fulfil <u>all</u> righteousness"
- 3. The <u>EARLY CHURCH</u> also set the example for us (Acts 2:41). First Disciples (Acts 22:16 told to "Get up, be Baptized...calling on His name.")

II. Meaning of baptism

- 1. It is a sign that we are FOLLOWERS of Jesus (Matthew 28:18-20). Disciples
- 2. Therefore, you must <u>ACCEPT CHRIST</u> before being baptized. (*Romans Road*: 3:23; 6:23; 5:8; and 10:9 or **Bridge Illustration**: 6:23)
- 3. It signifies that we have already been FORGIVEN our sins (Acts 2:38).
- 4. Through baptism the <u>HOLY SPIRIT</u> imparts His grace to us in a special way (Acts 2:38).
- 5. Baptism demonstrates that we are one with Jesus in his <u>DEATH</u> and RESURRECTION (Romans 6:3-11, Galatians 2:20).
- 6. Thus, it is a sign of <u>DEATH</u> to our old life and the birth of a <u>NEW LIFE</u> (Romans 6:3-11; 2 Corinthians 5:17).
- 7. Greek word **baptizo** means to <u>IMMERSE</u>, so we baptize by immersion. (Bury only part of a dead person?)
- 8. The same word was also used in the manufacturing of <u>CLOTH (DYE)</u>.

III. Mechanics of baptizing at Grace

- 1. Be sure to invite family, friends, co-workers, etc; it's a great witness.
- 2. You will be baptized "into the name of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit and into the name of our Lord Jesus Christ" (Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 8:16 & Acts 19:5).
- 3. Please wear light colored tee shirt and shorts over your swim wear. We will supply you with a robe; be sure to take off anything you don't want to get wet!
- 4. One of our mini-church pastors will likely perform the baptism.
- 5. Cross your arms on your chest as you go under the water; if you wish, you can hold your nose shut with one hand.
- 6. Please give us the exact spelling of your name, as you want it on your certificate.
